**WYBRON'S AWARD-WINNING NEXERALX™ LUMINAIRES TO SPOTLIGHT  
COMPANY BOOTH AT LDI 2006**

Colorado Springs, CO – October 20, 2006 – Wybron, Inc., a leader of entertainment and architectural lighting technology, today announced that NexeraLX, its line of affordable luminaires with built-in patent pending dichroic CMY color mixing, will actively spotlight Wybron's booth (No. 1731) at Lighting Dimensions International (LDI) 2006 tradeshow in Las Vegas. Theatrical demand for NexeraLX profiles and wash lights continues to increase since the product line launch three years ago.

The six NexeraLX luminaires consist of:



- four profile models, two with a beam angle of 19 to 26 degrees and two with 25 to 40 degrees with either a tungsten or CDM source.
- two fresnel-based wash light models with an adjustable field of 25 to 33 degrees with either a tungsten or CDM source.
- both sources provide superb light output and beam uniformity.
- profile models accept standard M size patterns.
- all are convection cooled for virtually silent operation.

“The Nexera is perfect for theatrical applications as the color mixing is very smooth and extremely quiet,” said Larry Turner, CEO of Wybron.

Each model requires 3 DMX channels for color mixing, thus the fixtures are easy to use and patch even on the simplest of control consoles. The CDM source models use a fourth DMX channel to mechanically dim the unit. Color changes can be made in real time, allowing fine tuning to be done “on the fly.”

All Nexera luminaries share a common lamp housing, borosilicate cold mirror reflector, and Wybron CMY dichroic color mixing module for ease of service and flexibility. The Wybron CMY module offers a menu display for DMX addressing and operational information, and the system is RDM compliant. All models accommodate standard sized fitted accessories, such as gel frames, snoots, barn doors and donuts.

Michael Maag, Master Electrician at the Oregon Shakespeare Festival which employs 46 Nexeras split between two theaters states, "When I tested the Nexeras they were virtually silent, and the other units I tested were unacceptably loud. We went with all Nexera profiles for the simple reason of what they do best: theater. The fast, silent and rich colors of the Nexera help us to convey time, place and mood."
